

## Questions to the farmer:

# We share a sea. Diet for a clean Baltic

Before visiting the farm, you should discuss in class what you want the farmer to tell you about. Prepare a questionnaire. You may use these questions:

1. How much land is there to the farm?<sup>1</sup>
2. Which animals are on the farm?
3. How many animals are there?
4. How is the manure from the animals used - as solid dung or slurry?
5. Which crops does the farmer grow on his land?
6. How is his crop rotation? (the order of crops)
7. Are there legumes in the crop rotation?
8. Which kind of legumes?

<sup>1</sup> The acreage of the farm is measured in acres - one hectare is 10,000 square meters. This represents about two football fields
