Before visiting the fishing harbor you should discuss in class what you want the fisherman to tell you about. Prepare a questionnaire. You may use these questions:

1. Which sea does the cutter sail in?
2. What kind of fish can you catch there?
3. Which species does the fisherman you visit catch?
4. Which methods and what equipment does he use when he goes fishing?
5. Why has he chosen this fishing method?
6. How many fishermen are there in the fishing harbour?
7. How many were there 50 years ago?
8. What is the reason for this development?
9. Has the fisherman experienced oxygen depletion and fish die-off in "his" waters?
10. If it happened – when was it and what was the reason?
11. If it happened – what were the consequences for the fisherman and his trade?
12. Has he experienced other problems with water pollution – which problems?
