1. Make a list of the ten capitals around the Baltic Sea
2. Make a list of the ten countries around the Baltic Sea. Begin with the country with the largest population and finish with the country with the fewest inhabitants. (You may include Kaliningrad as a country, even though it belongs to Russia)
3. Make a new list of the ten countries. Begin with the country with the largest area and finish with the one with the smallest.
4. Which country is the largest?
5. Which country is the smallest?
6. Look at the map. Which country has the longest coastline?
7. Which country has the largest share of farming land measured in percentage (We do not consider Russia and Kalingrad here)
8. Which country uses the smallest share of it area to farming measured in percentage (excluding Russia and Kalingrad)
9. Three countries have flags with crosses. Which ones?
10. There are nine states around the Baltic Sea, but only three small countries are usually referred to as "the Baltic States". What are their names? You may use Google if you don't know it (it doesn't say in the book).
